REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3(2) OF THE
TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES ORDINANCE.

THE TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1958

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Travelling Allowances (Amendment) Regulations, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Travelling Allowances Regulations, 1953, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 76 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph (i) thereof the following paragraph:—

“(i) The following public officers may when travelling on official duty between Trinidad and Tobago avail themselves of the air services:—

- (a) Heads and Deputy Heads of Departments;
- (b) Judges of the Supreme Court;
- (c) Law Officers of the Crown;
- (d) Officers whose salaries are not less than \$6,000 per annum.

All other officers shall travel by coastal steamer provided that in a case of emergency Heads of Departments may authorise an officer whose salary is less than \$6,000 per annum to travel by air and shall immediately after giving such authorisation satisfy the Accountant General of the special circumstances of each case."
