REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER THE TRAVELLING
ALLOWANCES ORDINANCE

THE TRAVELLING ALLOWANCES REGULATIONS, 1966

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Travelling Allowances (Amendment) Regulations, 1966.

2. Regulation 60 of the Travelling Allowances Regulations, 1953 is amended as follows:—

- (a) by re-numbering the said regulation 60 as regulation 60 (1), and
- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following:

“(2) Notwithstanding regulation 60 (1) (a), the Minister of Finance may, in his discretion, approve the making of an advance to an officer on temporary appointment upon such terms and conditions as he thinks fit, if the Minister is satisfied that the special circumstances of his case warrant the making of such advance.”

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, CH. 33. No. 3

ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE
AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES (UNIVERSAL METAL COMPANY
LIMITED) (BENDING AND SLOTTING OF METAL) ORDER, 1966

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Universal Metal Company Limited) (Bending and Slotting of Metal) Order, 1966.

2. Universal Metal Company Limited, a company registered under the Companies Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as the "pioneer company") is hereby declared to be a pioneer manufacturer for the purposes

of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") in relation to—

—1965
- (a) its pioneer factory located at the North-Eastern corner of Macoya Road, and Churchill-Roosevelt Highway, in the Ward of Tacarigua, and
 - (b) the bending and slotting of metal in Trinidad and Tobago on a commercial scale, by the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Bending and Slotting of Metal) Order, 1965, declared to be a pioneer industry, with effect from the 1st day of July, 1965, and the production day of the said factory is hereby declared to be the 1st day of January, 1967.

3. The effect of this Order shall be restricted to the type of product "iron so bent and slotted".

4. This Order is subject to the following continuing conditions:—

- (a) that the pioneer company shall keep its pioneer factory equipped with the following minimum items of equipment—
 - (i) One (1) slotting and perforating machine; and
 - (ii) One (1) angle making machine;
- (b) that the pioneer company shall maintain accounts in respect of the pioneer enterprise to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Income Tax;
- (c) that the pioneer company shall—
 - (i) observe the practice and policy generally accepted in Trinidad and Tobago with respect to labour relations and conditions of employment;
 - (ii) as far as practicable recruit its employees through the Ministry of Labour;
- (d) that, notwithstanding the exemption from income tax under section 8 of the Ordinance, the pioneer company shall submit annually a return of the income so exempt from tax at the same time and in the same manner as it would be required to do if the income were not exempt from tax.
