AN ORDINANCE to amend the Old Age Pensions
Ordinance, Ch. 13. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Old Age Pensions
(Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be read as one
with the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, as amended by the Old
Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, which Ordinance
as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal
Ordinance.

2. The Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by the addition of the following section to be numbered section 10:—

“Retrospective
operation

10. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1951”.

Validation of
payments

3. All payments made under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance which would have been validly and properly made thereunder if section 2 of this Ordinance had then been enacted shall be deemed to be and to have been validly and properly made.
