1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Old Age Pensions  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with  
the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to  
as the Principal Ordinance. Short title and

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1954.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, as amended by section 3 of the Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951-1953, is hereby further amended by substituting the words "nine" and "twelve" for the words "seven" and "ten" respectively.
