AN ORDINANCE to amend the Old Age Pensions
Ordinance, Ch. 13. No. 2.Commence
ment

[1st January, 1960]

Enactment.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

Ch. 13. No. 2.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Old Age Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by deleting subsection (2) thereof and by substituting the following: Section 3 of Principal Ordinance amended.

"Amount of pension.

(2) The pension shall be at the monthly rate of ten dollars or such portion thereof as together with the pensioner's monthly means, calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, will amount to not more than fifteen dollars per month, but in no case shall the pension be less than five dollars per month."

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1960. Commencement.

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of October in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty.
