TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE TREASURY BILLS ORDINANCE, 1960

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the power to borrow money by the issue of Treasury Bills is authorised by the Treasury Bills Ordinance, 1960, hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance":

And whereas subsection (1) of section 3 of the Ordinance provides that the Minister of Finance, whenever authorised thereto by a Resolution of Parliament may borrow sums not exceeding the amount specified in such Resolution by the issue of Treasury Bills.

*Be it resolved:*

That this House under the provisions of subsection (1) of section 3 of the Ordinance authorise the Minister of Finance to borrow sums not exceeding in the aggregate an amount of \$100,000,000 by the issue of Treasury Bills.
