AN ACT to amend the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, Ch. 13.
No. 2.

[Assented to 4th May, 1964]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Old Age Pensions Short title
(Amendment) Act, 1964.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Old Age Pensions Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:—

“Amount of pension (2) The pension shall be at a monthly rate of fourteen dollars or such portion thereof as together with the pensioner’s monthly means, calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, will amount to not more than nineteen dollars per month, but in no case shall the pension be less than five dollars per month.”

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1964.
