TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 55 of 1970

AN ACT to amend the Old Age Pensions Ordinance,
Ch. 13. No. 2.

[Assented to 6th January, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by ^{Enactment} and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Old Age Pensions ^{Short title} (Amendment) Act, 1970.

Section 3 of
Ch. 13, No. 2
amended.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Old Age Pensions Ordinance is repealed and replaced as follows—

“Amount of
pension.

(2) The pension shall be at a monthly rate of eighteen dollars or such portion thereof as together with the pensioner's monthly means calculated in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, will amount to not more than twenty-three dollars per month, but in no case shall the pension be less than five dollars per month.”

Commencement. 3. This Act shall be deemed to come into operation on the 1st January, 1971.
