**Act No. 18 of 1974**

AN ACT to amend the Old Age Pensions Ordinance,  
Ch. 13. No. 2.

*[Assented to 5th July, 1974]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment  
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House  
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Old Age Pensions Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 1974.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Old Age Pensions Ordinance is amended by substituting—

- (a) the words “thirty dollars” for the words “eighteen dollars” appearing in line two thereof;
- (b) the words “thirty-five dollars” for the words “twenty-three dollars” appearing in line seven thereof; and
- (c) the words “seventeen dollars” for the words “five dollars” appearing in line nine thereof.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1974.
