AN ACT to amend the Old Age Pensions Ordinance,
Ch. 13. No. 2.

[Assented to 27th March, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Old Age Pensions ^{Short title}
(Amendment) Act, 1975.

Ch. 13. No. 2
amended.

2. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Old Age Pensions Ordinance is amended by substituting—

- (a) the words “forty-five dollars” for the words “thirty dollars” occurring in line two thereof;
- (b) the words “fifty dollars” for the words “thirty-five dollars” occurring in line seven thereof; and
- (c) the words “thirty-two dollars” for the words “seventeen dollars” occurring in line nine thereof.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1975.
