

LEGAL NOTICE No. 59

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE SHOP (HOURS OF OPENING AND EMPLOYMENT) ACT,
CHAP. 84:02

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 5 of the Shop (Hours of Opening and Employment) Act, Chap. 84:02, that the Minister may make an Order (in the Act referred to as a "Shop Order") fixing the hours (in the Act referred to as "the Opening Hours") on the several days of the week including Sundays and Public Holidays, during which, either throughout the whole of Trinidad and Tobago or in any specified area thereof, all shops or shops of any specified class may be opened for serving customers:

And whereas it is provided by subsection (3) of the said section 5 that a Shop Order made under the Act shall be subject to affirmative resolution of Parliament:

And whereas the Minister has on 11th day of April, 1983 made the Shop (Hours of Opening and Employment) (Siparia Fete) Order, 1983 whereby licensed liquor shops within a one-mile radius of the Magistrate's Court, Siparia may open during the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Sunday, 17th April, 1983.

And whereas it is expedient that the said Order now be affirmed:

Be it Resolved :

That the Shop (Hours of Opening and Employment) (Siparia Fete) Order, 1983 be approved.
