REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 64 OF THE SPIRITS
AND SPIRIT COMPOUNDS ORDINANCE

THE SPIRITS AND SPIRIT COMPOUNDS (EXPORTATION FROM
WAREHOUSE) REGULATIONS, 1959

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Compounds
(Exportation from Warehouse) Regulations, 1959.

2. The proper officer may, subject to the provisions of Section 64 of the
Spirits and Spirit Compounds Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 9, grant permits for
the removal and exportation from the Colony of warehoused spirits and
spirit compounds in bottles packed in cases containing not less than $16\frac{2}{3}$
hundredths of a gallon.

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, CH. 32, No. 2

REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMPTROLLER OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE UNDER SECTION 41
OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

THE CUSTOMS (EXPORTATION OF LIQUOR) REGULATIONS, 1959

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Exportation of
Liquor) Regulations, 1959.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section 40 of
the Customs Ordinance, rum, spirits and wines may be exported in bottles
properly packed in cases containing not less than $16\frac{2}{3}$ hundredths of a gallon.
