## REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE COMPTROLLER OF CUSTOMS AND EXCISE UNDER SECTION 21 OF  
THE SPIRITS AND SPIRIT COMPOUNDS ORDINANCETHE SPIRITS AND SPIRIT COMPOUNDS (DISTILLERY)  
REGULATIONS, 1955

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Compounds (Distillery) Regulations, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Spirits and Spirit Compounds (Distillery) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by adding immediately after the paragraph “(e) Colouring Matter Book” occurring therein, the following new paragraph:

“(f) Account Book of Spirits Received and Gin Manufactured”.

(b) by adding thereafter the following provisoes:—

“Provided that a Distiller who manufactures gin only shall not be required to keep the books respectively denoted (a), (c) and (e):

And provided also that a Distiller who does not manufacture gin shall not be required to keep the book denoted (f).”
