ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE STANDARDS ACT

THE COMPULSORY STANDARD ORDER, 1999

WHEREAS it is provided by section 18(2) of the Standards Act ^{Preamble} (hereinafter called "the Act"), that a compulsory standard Order shall ^{No. 18 of 1997} state the purposes for which the standard is intended:

And whereas this compulsory standard Order has become necessary in order to prevent fraud or deception arising from misleading labelling:

Now, therefore, the Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by the said section 18 of the Act, hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Compulsory Standard Order, ^{Citation} 1999.

2. On the recommendation of the Bureau, the standard referred to ^{Compulsory} below, the notice of which was published in Legal Notice No. 279 of ^{Standard} 1998, is declared a compulsory standard ^{declared}.
