| Compulsory standards declared | 2. On the recommendation of the Bureau, the standards referred to in the Schedule, the declaration of which was notified in Legal Notice No. 163 of 2003, are declared compulsory standards.  |
| Purpose of standards          | 3. The purpose of the standards referred to in the Schedule, is to protect the consumer or user against danger to health or safety and to ensure acceptable quality in any case where there is restriction in choice of source of supply. |
| Commencement                  | 4. This Order comes into effect on the 3rd day of November, 2003.   |
