AN ORDINANCE to exempt the University College of the West Indies from payment of Duties of Customs and Excise, Stamp Duties, Lands and Buildings Taxes and Rates.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the University Short title.
College Exemption Ordinance, 1960.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor may appoint by Proclamation published in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Notwithstanding the Customs Ordinance and the Excise (General Provisions) Ordinance, no customs duties or excise duties are payable upon any goods imported into the Territory of Trinidad and Tobago by the University College of the West Indies or taken out of bond in Trinidad and Tobago by the University College of the West Indies, if the goods are shown to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs and Excise to be required for the use of the University College.

3. The Schedule to the Stamp Duty Ordinance is amended by adding under the heading "General Exemptions From All Stamp Duties" immediately following the last sentence thereof, the following:—

"Instruments executed by or on behalf of the University College of the West Indies."

4. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after paragraph (d) thereof the following paragraph:

"(e) lands and buildings belonging to and in the occupation of the University College of the West Indies or its immediate servants." ✓

5. Section 2 of the Taxes Exemption Ordinance is amended by inserting therein immediately after paragraph (c) thereof the following paragraph:

"(d) all lands and buildings belonging to and in the occupation of the University College of the West Indies or its immediate servants."
