RULES

MADE BY THE RACING AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY ACT

THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY
(AMENDMENT) RULES, 1992

1. These Rules may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority Citation
(Amendment) Rules, 1992.

2. In these Rules, "the Rules" means the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority Rules, 1989. Interpretation

3. Rule 6(1) of the Rules is amended by deleting paragraph (j) and
substituting the following paragraph: Rule 6
amended

"(j) refuse to accept or cancel at anytime any entry subject to the
following conditions:

- (i) reasons in writing shall be given to the Authority;
- (ii) a written notification of the refusal or cancellation shall be hand-delivered within twenty-four hours thereof, to either the authorized agent or the person holding the power of entry and to the trainer; and
- (iii) failure to comply with the requirements in subparagraphs (i) and (ii) shall result in the entry being deemed to be accepted, except where it is rejected on the ground of a breach of the Rules."

4. Rule 34 is amended by repealing subrule (1) and substituting the following: Rule 34
amended

" 34. (1) Entries shall be made in writing on the prescribed form and must be signed by the trainer named on the entry form and by the following:

- (a) the registered owner or the authorized agent of that person;
- (b) in the case of a partnership, the person with whom the power of entry rests or the authorized agent of that person; or
- (c) in the case of a syndicate or registered company, the authorized agent of the syndicate or the registered company."

5. Rule 39 is amended by adding after subrule (10) the following subrules: Rule 39
amended

" (11) An owner shall pay the following fees per mount:

- (a) to jockeys, the sum of seventy-five dollars; and
- (b) to apprentice jockeys, the sum of fifty dollars.

(12) The fees specified in subrule (11) shall be deposited with the Clerk of the Scales or his authorized substitute before a jockey or apprentice jockey is weighed-out."

**Rule 71
amended**

6. Rule 71 is amended by adding after subrule (2) the following subrules:
“ (3) The use of public, cellular or any other kind of telephone at race courses is prohibited unless the consent of the Steward is obtained.

(4) Any person who, is found using a public, cellular or any other kind of telephone, or communicating device without the consent of the Stewards or in connection with illegal wagering or the transmission of any kind of information regarding odds, race results or other gambling information, shall be excluded forthwith from the premises by the Stewards and shall be reported to the Authority and that person may be warned off all race courses or may be declared a disqualified person by the Authority.”.
