AN ORDINANCE to amend the Truck Ordinance,
Cap. 156.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:

Short title.
Construction.
Cap. 156.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Truck (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall be construed as one with the Truck Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Addition of
Sec. 11A to
Principal
Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto after Section 11 the following new Section as Section 11A:—

Exemption
from
provisions
of Ordinance
for protection
of labourers.

11A. (1) The Governor in Executive Council, if satisfied that the provisions of this Ordinance are unnecessary for the protection of the labourers employed in any trade or business, or in any branch or department of any trade or business, either generally or within any specified area, may by order under his hand grant an exemption from those provisions in respect of the persons engaged in that trade, business, branch or department, either generally or within that area.

(2) An Order made under this Section shall not have any force or effect until it has been approved by resolution of the Legislative Council, and when so approved shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*, and from the date of such publication, or from the date specified therein, such order shall have the same force and effect as if it were contained in and formed part of the Principal Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for payment of half-yearly
licence fees in respect of motor omnibuses.**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and
Road Traffic (Licensing of Motor Omnibuses) Ordinance, 1937,
Construction. and shall be construed as one with the Motor Vehicles and
No. 42—1934. Road Traffic Ordinance, 1934, and all amendments thereto,
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Payment of
half-yearly
licence fee for
motor
omnibuses. 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in
Section 19 of the Principal Ordinance, the Licensing
Authority may issue in respect of a motor omnibus a half-
yearly licence upon payment of half the yearly licence fee
specified in the First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance,
and every such half-yearly licence shall expire on such
30th day of June or 31st day of December as shall first
happen after the issue thereof.

Duration of
Ordinance. 3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the 1st day
of January, 1938, and shall continue in force until the
31st day of December, 1938.
