THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE SANTA ROSA PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
ORDER, 1980

1. This Order may be cited as the Santa Rosa Park Races (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1980. Citation
2. This Order shall come into operation at 11.30 a.m. and shall cease at 7.00 p.m. on the 10th, 17th, 24th, 26th and 31st May, and 7th June, 1980. Commence-
ment and
cessation
3. No person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the roads mentioned below at the times shown in paragraph 2 of this Order— Parking
prohibited
on certain
roads
 - (a) O'Meara Road;
 - (b) O'Meara Ferry Road between Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and a point 200 yards South of the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park;
 - (c) Churchill-Roosevelt Highway between the western entrance to Santa Rosa Park and O'Meara Road;
 - (d) the roads leading to and from the Arima Race Club Buildings.
4. Between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.— One-way
traffic
 - (a) vehicular traffic shall enter Santa Rosa Park from the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway by way of the western entrance and shall leave by way of the north-eastern entrance;
 - (b) vehicular traffic shall proceed in a northerly direction only between the eastern entrance to the Race Stand and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.
5. Between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m.— Traffic
flow
 - (a) vehicular traffic shall enter Santa Rosa Park by way of O'Meara Ferry Road and shall leave by way of the western entrance leading to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway;
 - (b) vehicular traffic shall proceed in a southerly direction only along O'Meara Ferry Road between the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park.

Parking

6. Vehicles shall be parked in the Santa Rosa Park in accordance with the direction of the police officer on duty.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78C of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.
