AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GRANTS AND LEASES OF CROWN
LAND WHICH HAVE BEEN LOST OR DESTROYED.

ment.

[17th November, 1904.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Crown Grants and Leases (Re-issue) Ordinance.

Certificate
of loss or
destruction.

2. (1) Whenever it shall appear to the satisfaction of the Governor that any grant of land alienated in fee from the Crown before the 9th of August, 1889, or any lease of Crown lands, has been destroyed or lost, the Governor may certify to the issue of such grant or lease.

(2) Such certificate shall state the date on which the grant or lease of Crown lands was issued, the name of the person to whom issued, the description of the parcel of land, and the nature and extent of the estate or interest granted or leased, and may be in the form to the Schedule hereto, or in such other form as the circumstances of the case may require.

(3) Every such certificate shall be signed by the Governor and shall be under the Public Seal of the Colony and shall be registered in the office of the Registrar General.

(4) Every such certificate shall, when registered as aforesaid, be admissible in evidence in all courts of justice, to the same extent and for the same purposes as the original grant or lease would have been admissible.

Proof of
interest.

3. (1) Any person applying for a certificate under the last preceding section shall, in addition to the proof of the

destruction or loss of such grant or lease, furnish proof of his interest therein.

(2) The Governor may require the lands in respect of which a certificate is applied for to be surveyed, and the application for such certificate to be advertised in the *Royal Gazette* and in such other newspaper as he may direct, and the cost of such survey and advertisement shall be paid by the applicant.
