TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

TRADING WITH THE ENEMY

ENEMY TERRITORY CESSATION (AUSTRIA)

THE GOVERNOR, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Regulation 9 of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1940, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Austria) Order, 1953.

2. Austria shall for all purposes of the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance, 1939, and for the purposes of any Order made thereunder cease to be treated as if it were enemy territory as from the date of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Regulation 9 of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939 (as enacted by Regulation 3 of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) (Amendment) Regulations, 1944) made the whole of the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance and the Orders made thereunder continue to apply, until the Governor otherwise orders, to areas which were under enemy sovereignty at that date.

By virtue of the present Order, Austria ceases to be regarded as enemy territory for all purposes of the said Ordinance and Orders.
