ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (ENEMY TERRITORY  
CESSATION) (NETHERLANDS) ORDER, 1957

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Netherlands) Order, 1957.

2. In this Order—

“the Netherlands” means all the territory in Europe of the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Netherlands New Guinea;

Ch. 42. No. 7. “the Ordinance” means the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance.

3. The Netherlands shall for the purposes of sections 5A, 6, 7 and 9 of the Ordinance and for the purposes of any Order made under section 9 of the Ordinance cease to be treated as if they were enemy territory as from the date of this Order.
