AN ORDINANCE for the Incorporation of certain persons  
as Trustees of The Sanatan Dharma Board of Control.

WHEREAS The Sanatan Dharma Board of Control was Preamble.  
registered as a Friendly and Benevolent Society under  
the Friendly Societies Ordinance, Chapter 286, on the  
15th day of January, 1932 ;

And whereas by a resolution of the Governing Body  
of the said Sanatan Dharma Board of Control, Pundit  
Ramnarine and Pundit Balgobin, both of Arouca, in the  
Ward of Tacarigua, in the County of St. George, were  
appointed Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Board of  
Control ; and by a further Resolution dated the 15th day of  
May, 1932, Pundit Sahadeo Tiwari Sharma of Tunapuna,  
in the said Ward of Tacarigua, was appointed an additional  
Trustee of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control.

And whereas by two Resolutions of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control duly passed on the 7th day of February, 1932, and the 15th day of May, 1932, respectively, it was resolved that Pundit Sahadeo Tiwari Sharma and Pundit Ramnarine and Pundit Balgobin, the three Trustees of the Society, be incorporated under the name "The Incorporated Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control" with power to hold lands and other property in trust for the Society, and to carry out the lawful duties conferred on them by the Rules of the Society;

And whereas it is expedient that the said Trustees should be incorporated;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Sanatan Dharma Board of Control (Incorporation) Ordinance, 1932.

Incorporation of Trustees.

2. Pundit Sahadeo Tiwari Sharma of Tunapuna and Pundit Balgobin and Pundit Ramnarine, both of Arouca, in the Ward of Tacarigua in the County of St. George, Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control and their Successors in office as Trustees shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control", and by that name shall have perpetual succession and shall have full power to purchase, take, hold and enjoy all lands, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind soever in perpetuity or for a term of life, or years, and also all manner of goods and chattels whatsoever, and shall and may sue and be sued in all Courts of Justice in the Colony, and shall have and use a common seal, which may from time to time be changed.

Power to hold Property.

Trustees may dispose of property.

3. It shall be lawful for "The Incorporated Trustees of the Sanatan Dharma Board of Control", from time to time by deed under the Seal of the body corporate above defined, to sell, demise, grant, convey, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of any lands, buildings, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind soever which shall have been or shall hereafter be purchased, taken, held, or enjoyed by such corporate body.

4. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of His Majesty, His Heirs or Successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or are referred to in this Ordinance and those claiming by, through, from or under them. Saving of Crown and other rights.
