**Act No. 38 of 1966**

AN ACT to amend the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance,  
Ch. 14. No. 6

*[Assented to 30th December, 1966]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by  
the authority of the same as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Teachers' Pensions <sup>Short title</sup>  
(Amendment) Act, 1966.

2. (1) Section 7 of the Teachers' Pensions Ordinance is amended by substituting for subsection (3) thereof the following :—

“Teachers  
whose  
service is  
terminated  
in public  
interest in  
certain  
circum-  
stances  
may be  
retired

(3) Where a teacher's service is terminated on the ground that having regard to the conditions of the teaching service, the usefulness of the teacher thereto and all the other circumstances of the case, such termination is desirable in the public interest, and a pension, gratuity or other allowance cannot otherwise be granted to him under the provisions of this Ordinance, the Governor-General may, if he thinks fit, grant such pension, gratuity or other allowance as he thinks just and proper, not exceeding in amount that for which the officer would be eligible if he retired from the teaching service by reason of some infirmity of mind or body likely to be permanent in the circumstances described in subsection (1).”

(2) The amendment set out in subsection (1) shall be deemed to have had effect from the 1st day of January, 1965.
