

group X shall not fly over water so as to be more than 60 minutes' flying time from the nearest shore unless it has more than two power units. For the purpose of this Regulation, flying time shall be calculated at normal cruising speed with one power unit inoperative."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (General) Regulations, 1959, as amended, in respect of weight and performance regulations with which aeroplanes must comply before they are allowed to take off.

UNDER SUBSECTION (4) OF SECTION 9 OF THE TEACHERS PENSIONS
