TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE STATUTORY AUTHORITIES ACT, 1966

DELEGATION OF POWERS BY THE STATUTORY AUTHORITIES' SERVICE COMMISSION UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 5 OF THE STATUTORY AUTHORITIES' ACT, 1966

To : *The Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago*

UNDER and by virtue of the provisions of subsection (2) of section 5 of the Statutory Authorities Act, 1966, the Statutory Authorities Service Commission, with the approval of the Prime Minister, hereby delegates to the Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago (hereinafter referred to as "the Authority") the respective powers of the Statutory Authorities' Service Commission detailed hereunder:—

A. *Appointments*

The power to make appointments (including acting appointments), to promote and to confirm appointments of persons to offices in the Authority.

B. *Transfers and Secondment*

The power to approve of the transfer or secondment of an officer in the service of the Authority to the service of another Authority, Body or Organization with which the Authority has contractual relations in respect of the performance of functions vested in the Authority.

In exercise of the powers hereby delegated the Authority shall be guided by the regulations set out in Chapters III and V of the Statutory Authorities' Service Commission Regulations, 1968, in so far as they are applicable.

The Authority shall submit to the Statutory Authorities' Service Commission once in every quarter, a report of the exercise of any of the powers hereby delegated.

The powers hereby delegated are subject to modification, variation, or revocation at any time.
