DELEGATION OF POWERS BY THE STATUTORY AUTHORITIES  
SERVICE COMMISSION

[Under subsection (2) of section 5 of the Statutory Authorities  
Act, 1966]

TO: THE PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE CORPORATION

UNDER and by virtue of the provisions of subsection (2) of section 5 of the Statutory Authorities Act, 1966, the Statutory Authorities Service Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") with the approval of the Prime Minister, hereby delegates to the Public Transport Service Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") the powers of the Statutory Authorities Service Commission detailed hereunder—

*Applications for appointments:—*

The power to invite applications for appointments to vacant posts, to interview applicants and to submit a short list with firm recommendations to the Commission.

The exercise of the powers hereby delegated to the Corporation shall be guided by the regulations set out in Chapters III and V of the Statutory Authorities Service Commissions Regulations, 1968, in so far as they are applicable.

The powers hereby delegated are subject to modification, variation or revocation at any time.
