ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(SOUTH STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 1989

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (South Steelband Panorama) Order, 1989.
2. This Order has effect from 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Saturday, 21st January, 1989, and from 5.00 p.m. to 12.00 midnight on Wednesday, 25th January, 1989. Commencement and cessation
3. Motorists may park their vehicles on the following roads in the manner stated— Parking restricted
 - (a) Princess Margaret Street—on the western side only;
 - (b) Rambaransingh Street—on the northern side only;
 - (c) Turton Street—on the western side only;
 - (d) Prince Charles Street—on the southern side only.
4. Motorists using vehicles conveying steelbands to Skinner Park shall proceed West only along Park Street. Route to Skinner Park
5. The following streets shall be closed to vehicular traffic— Roads closed
 - (a) Cipero Street, between Donaldson Street and Rienzi/Kirton Highway;
 - (b) Park Street, between Cipero Street and Todd Street;
 - (c) Todd Street, between Scrimgeour Street and Rienzi/Kirton Highway;
 - (d) Scott Street, between Cipero Street and Richards Street.
6. Motorists using Shah Street shall proceed in a northerly direction only. One-way traffic
7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
