REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 23(2) OF THE POST OFFICE ORDINANCE

THE POST OFFICE (BRITISH POSTAL ORDERS) (ISSUE AND POUNDAGE) REGULATIONS, 1974

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (British Postal Orders) (Issue and Poundage) Regulations, 1974.

Denominations of British postal orders 2. (1) British postal orders payable at all Post Offices in the United Kingdom and in the British Possessions indicated in the London Post Office Guide, shall be issued in Trinidad and Tobago in denominations of ten, twelve and one-half, fifteen, twenty, twenty-five, forty, fifty, sixty and seventy-five new pence and one pound and two pound sterling.

(2) In this regulation "the London Post Office Guide" means the Post Office Guide issued by the British Post Office under the direction of Her Majesty's Postmaster General.

Poundage payable on British postal orders	3. British postal orders shall be subject to charges for poundage as follows:				
	For each order of 10 new pence	17 cents
	For each order of 12½ new pence	20 cents
	For each order of 15 new pence	18 cents
	For each order of 20 new pence	19 cents
	For each order of 25 new pence	20 cents
	For each order of 40 new pence	18 cents
	For each order of 50 new pence	20 cents
	For each order of 60 new pence	32 cents
	For each order of 75 new pence	30 cents
For each order of £1	30 cents	
For each order of £2	50 cents.
