MADE BY THE APPEAL BOARD UNDER SECTION 43C OF THE
INCOME TAX ORDINANCE

THE APPEAL BOARD (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1968

1. These Rules may be cited as the Appeal Board (Amendment) Rules, 1968.

2. The Appeal Board Rules, 1967 are hereby amended by substituting for rule 30 thereof the following rule:—

“Notice of hearing of appeal. 30. (1) Subject to rules 9 and 10, notice appointing the time and place of hearing of the appeal may be given by the Registrar to the parties at any time after the expiration of six weeks from the filing of the notice of appeal.

(2) A notice under this rule may be given notwithstanding that the Inland Revenue have failed to file a statement of case in accordance with these Rules.

Form H. (3) A notice under this rule shall follow as closely as may be Form H.”
