AGRICULTURAL CREDIT SOCIETIES ORDINANCE, 1954

(No. 6—1954)

NOTIFICATION

It is hereby notified that the Governor in Council, under the provisions of subsections (2) and (4) of section 58 of the Agricultural Credit Societies Ordinance, 1954, hereby:—

- (a) cancels the registration of the Chin Chin Road Agricultural Credit Society; and
- (b) authorises Mr. James Harper, Planter of St. Mary's Village, Carapichaima, the nominee of the Commissioner for Agricultural Credit Societies, to sue for and recover all loans from the members of the said society liable for the repayment of the same as if they had been originally advanced by the said nominee to such members.
