AN ACT to amend the Stamp Duty Ordinance.

[Assented to 25th June, 1980]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Stamp Duty (Amend-Short title
ment) Act, 1980.

Amendment of
Ch. 33. No. 4

2. The Schedule to the Stamp Duty Ordinance is hereby amended by—

- (a) substituting the figures “10” for the figures “05” in the second column opposite the item—“BILL OF EXCHANGE, Cheque or Order, payable on demand or at sight, or on presentation, or within three days after date or sight”;
- (b) inserting under “EXEMPTIONS” immediately after the item “Cheques issued by the Post Master General under the Post Office Savings Bank Ordinance” the following new item—
“Travellers Cheques (to be known as Caricom Travellers Cheques) issued by the Central Bank of Trinidad and Tobago pursuant to the terms of the Treaty Establishing the Caribbean Community and the Annex thereto.”

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1980.
