A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (3) of section 23 of the Summary Offences Ordinance, Ch. 4. No. 17, that the expression "growing crops" includes any fruit, vegetable or product which the Governor in Council may, by proclamation, direct to be included within the definition of growing crops, whatever the value of the articles stolen may be, and whether the land on which the same is at the time growing or in course of cultivation be open or enclosed :

And whereas it is expedient that certain fruit, vegetables and products be included within the definition of "growing crops":

Now, therefore, I, EDWARD BETHAM BEETHAM, Governor as aforesaid, hereby, in Executive Council, direct that the several fruit, vegetables and products set out in the Schedule hereto shall be included within the definition of growing crops.
