

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Conviction
Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1918.

[22nd December, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1921. Short title.

2. Section 3 of the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1918, is hereby amended by inserting the following as sub-section (1a.):— Assistant Magistrate for Port-of-Spain.

(1a.) His Majesty may from time to time by warrant under the hand of the Governor and the Seal of the Colony appoint any person to

be Assistant Magistrate for the magisterial district of St. George West. Such Assistant Magistrate shall have and exercise all the powers, privileges, rights and jurisdiction of a magistrate appointed under this section, and the provisions of this section shall apply to such Assistant Magistrate in the same manner as they apply to a magistrate.
