THE SUMMARY COURTS (COSTS ON APPEAL) RULES, 1958

1. These Rules may be cited as the Summary Courts (Costs on Appeal) Short title.

2. In these Rules—

3. In the case of an appeal against a conviction or order of a Magistrate  
or Justice, if at the time when notice of appeal is given or within 24 hours  
thereafter application is made by the appellant or the respondent to the Clerk  
of the Court for the notes of evidence taken at the trial, the Clerk shall furnish  
the Registrar of the Supreme Court with a copy of such notes for delivery  
free of charge to the appellant and respondent.

4. Notices required by section 136 of the Ordinance to be given by the  
Clerk may be served either as provided in subsection (2) of that section or  
by delivering a copy of it to him personally, or, if he cannot be found, by  
leaving a copy of it with some person for him at his normal or last known  
place of abode.

5. The fees and costs recoverable by any party on an appeal from a  
Summary Court shall be determined in accordance with the scale set forth  
in the Schedule hereto.
