REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES (DIPLOMATIC, CONSULAR AND
INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS) ACT, CHAP. 17:01

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 9 of the Privileges and Immunities (Diplomatic, Consular and International Organisations) Act, Chap. 17:01 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) that the President may by Order declare that any international or regional organisation or agency named or described in such Order shall, to such extent as specified in the Order, be accorded the privileges and immunities set out in the Fifth Schedule therein:

And whereas it is also provided by section 9 of the Act that every Order made under that section shall be subject to affirmative resolution of Parliament:

And whereas it is expedient that the Order now be affirmed:

Be it Resolved:

That the Privileges and Immunities (Caribbean Financial Action Task Force) Order, 1994 be approved.
