THE LAND ACQUISITION (DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION)  
(NO. 11) ORDER, 2001

- Citation            1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Declaration of Acquisition) (No. 11) Order, 2001.
- Declaration of acquisition    2. The parcel of land—
- (a) comprising 421.5 square metres more or less, situate along the Uriah Butler Highway, Warner Village, Charlieville in the Ward of Cunupia in the County of Caroni;
  - (b) described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 5th December, 1997 executed under Survey Order No. 180/97 and filed in the Lands and Surveys Division;
  - (c) having been declared by the President by Order by Legal Notice No. 241 of 2000 as land required for a public purpose and approved for such purpose by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by Resolution of the Senate on 8th May, 2001, and the House of Representatives on 11th May, 2001, has been acquired for the following purpose: The construction of a Feeder Road parallel to the Uriah Butler Highway.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land comprising approximately 421.5 square metres more or less, situate along the Uriah Butler Highway, Warner Village, Charlieville in the Ward of Cunupia in the County of Caroni and said to belong now or formerly to Sewnarine Maharaj.

The land is more particularly shown coloured raw sienna on a Survey Plan filed in Book 1140, Folio 223 in the vault of the Lands and Surveys Department, Red House, Port-of-Spain.
