**Act No. 24 of 1982**

AN ACT to require applicants for certain licences to satisfy licensing authorities that planning permission has been granted.

*[Assented to 7th September, 1982]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago Enactment follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Town and Country Short title Planning (Miscellaneous Licences) Act, 1982.

2. Where under any enactment a licence is required to carry on any business or other activity on any land or in any building, a licence may not be granted, notwithstanding that the requirements of the enactment have been met, unless the applicant satisfies the licensing authority—

- (a) that permission was obtained under the Town and Country Planning Act for the development of that land or the use of that building for the purposes contemplated in the application for the licence; or
- (b) that such permission is not required.
