MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 50 OF THE WORKMEN'S
COMPENSATION ACT

THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (MEDICAL REFEREES)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1983

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation Citation
(Medical Referees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1983.

2. Regulation 12 of the Workmen's Compensation (Medical Referees) Regulations is revoked and replaced as follows—

"Fees

12. There shall be paid to a medical referee in relation
to a reference, the following fees—

- (a) for examination of the injured workman, issue of a certificate and all other duties performed in connection with the reference, a fee of eighty dollars;
- (b) where a medical referee is compelled to travel more than three kilometres from his residence (or such other centre as may be prescribed by the Minister) a fee of thirty-one cents in the case of a standard car or twenty-seven cents in the case of a light car, for each kilometre beyond three kilometres from such residence or centre."
