MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE SANTA ROSA PARK RACES (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
ORDER, 1987

1. This Order may be cited as the Santa Rosa Park Races (Temporary Citation Provisions) Order, 1987.
2. This Order comes into operation at 11.30 a.m. and ceases at 7.00 p.m. on each of the following days—  
Commence-  
ment and  
cessation
  - (a) Saturday, 22nd August, 1987;
  - (b) Saturday, 29th August, 1987;
  - (c) Monday, 31st August, 1987;
  - (d) Saturday, 5th September, 1987;
  - (e) Saturday, 12th September, 1987.
3. No person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the roads mentioned below between the times shown in paragraph 2 of this Order—  
Parking  
prohibited  
on certain  
roads
  - (a) O'Meara Road;
  - (b) O'Meara Ferry Road between the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and a point 200 yards South of the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park;
  - (c) the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway between the western entrance to Santa Rosa Park and O'Meara Road; and
  - (d) the roads leading to and from the Arima Race Club buildings.
4. Between the hours of 11.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. vehicular traffic shall—  
One-way  
traffic
  - (a) enter Santa Rosa Park from the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway by way of the western entrance and shall leave by way of the north-eastern entrance;
  - (b) proceed in a northerly direction only between the eastern entrance to the race stand and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.
5. Between the hours of 4.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. motorists shall—  
Entry into  
Santa Rosa  
Park
  - (a) enter Santa Rosa Park by way of O'Meara Ferry Road and shall leave by way of the western entrance leading to the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway;
  - (b) proceed in a southerly direction only along O'Meara Ferry Road between the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway and the eastern entrance to Santa Rosa Park.

**Parking**

6. Vehicles shall be parked in the Santa Rosa Park in accordance with the direction of the Police on duty.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 103(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
