A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Harbours Ordinance that the Governor may, by proclamation, alter the limits of any harbour:

And Whereas it is expedient that the limits of the harbour of San Fernando be altered:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Acting Governor as aforesaid, do hereby order and proclaim the limits of the harbour of San Fernando to be—

Such part of the Gulf of Paria as is comprised within a radius of $3\frac{1}{2}$ nautical miles from the Customs House of San Fernando;

And, further, I do hereby cancel Proclamation No. 2 of 1955, dated the 17th January, 1955.
