A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided *inter alia* by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Harbours Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 1, that the Governor-General may, by Proclamation, establish any harbour and define the limits thereof:

And whereas it is expedient that a harbour be established at Point Lisas and that the limits thereof be defined:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby establish the harbour of Point Lisas and define the limits thereof to be as follows:

All that portion of the Gulf of Paria, bounded on the North by half a mile radius from a Point in Latitude $10^{\circ} 22' 35''$ North—Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West to Latitude $10^{\circ} 23' 05''$ North—Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West due South to Latitude $10^{\circ} 22' 50''$ North, then parallel to the dredges channel Eastwards towards the shore line, bounded on to the South by half mile radius from Latitude $10^{\circ} 22' 35''$ North, Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West to Latitude $10^{\circ} 22' 05''$ North, Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West, then due North to Latitude $10^{\circ} 22' 20''$ North Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West then parallel to the above dredged channel Eastward towards the shore line.

Longitude $61^{\circ} 30' 44''$ West then parallel to the above dredged channel
