A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided *inter alia* by subsection (2) of section 3 of the Harbours Ordinance, Ch. 18. No. 1, that the Governor-General may by Proclamation establish any Harbour and define the limits thereof:

And whereas by Proclamation dated the 23rd day of June, 1890, a Harbour now called Brighton Harbour was established at La Brea and the limits thereof defined in accordance with the provisions of the said Ordinance:

And whereas it became necessary to define again the limits of the said Harbour by Proclamation dated on the 22nd day of February, 1897:

And whereas it has become necessary to define again the limits of the said Harbour:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby define the limits of the said Brighton Harbour as follows:—

All that portion of the Gulf of Paria enclosed by an imaginary line drawn from Point Galba in a direction $319^{\circ} 15'$ (T) to a position in Latitude $10^{\circ} 16' 35.8''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 40' 13.2''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 17' 05.4''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 39' 41.0''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 15' 22.0''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 38' 10.5''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 16' 00''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 36' 50''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 16' 52''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 36' 59''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 16' 56.6''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 26' 29.0''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 15' 48''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 36' 17''$ W. to Latitude $10^{\circ} 15' 03''$ N—

Longitude $61^{\circ} 37' 05''$ W. thence due South to the land.

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, CH. 33, No. 3

ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 3 (1) OF THE
AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES (MANUFACTURE OF STEEL
NUTS, BOLTS AND WASHERS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1967

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Steel Nuts, Bolts and Washers) (Amendment) Order, 1967.

2. Paragraph 2 of the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Steel Nuts, Bolts and Washers) Order, 1958, is revoked and replaced by the following paragraph—

“2. The manufacture of steel nuts, bolts, washers and rivets on a factory scale is hereby declared to be a pioneer industry and steel nuts, bolts, washers and rivets so manufactured are hereby declared to be pioneer products of that industry.”
