ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Special Adviser to enjoy Police Service pension rights.

Special Adviser (Protective Services) in the Ministry of

[1ST NOVEMBER 1973]

Commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Adviser (Protective Services) (Pension Rights) Act. ^{Short title.}

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, it is hereby declared that the person holding the office of Special Adviser (Protective Services) in the Ministry of National Security shall continue to enjoy pension rights similar to those he enjoyed as the holder of an office in the Police Service. ^{Special Adviser to enjoy Police Service pension rights.}
