**20.** The Minister may by Order published in the *Gazette* vary the Schedule by adding thereto or removing therefrom any petroleum product.

Power to make  
regulations

**21.** The Governor-General may make such regulations as he considers necessary or incidental to give effect to the provisions of this Act.

Transitional  
provision as to  
Orders under  
section 8(3)

**22.** Any Order made by the Minister under section 30A of the Petroleum Act or under section 8(3), that is expressed to have retrospective effect from the 1st February, 1974, shall by virtue of this section be deemed to have had effect from that date for all the purposes of this Act, and accordingly the subsidy and the levy shall be computed upon the prices, and at the gross margin therein specified.

Commencement

**23.** This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1974.
