**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Evidence (Amendment) Ordinance, 1912, and shall be read as one with the Evidence Ordinance, (No. 32.)
