AN ORDINANCE to amend the Evidence Ordinance,
(No. 32).

[By Proclamation.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Evidence (Amendment) Ordinance, 1918.

Amendment of Section 14. 2. The Evidence Ordinance (No. 32) shall be amended as follows :—

(1.) In lieu of paragraph (c) of Section 14 shall be read the following :—

(c.) The Post Office Savings Bank established under the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1918. In the case of the said Savings Bank "Banker" means the Postmaster-General.

- (2.) In lieu of the second paragraph of Section 20 ^{Amendment of Section 20.} shall be read the following :—

Such proof may be given by the Manager or Accountant of the Bank, and in the case of the Post Office Savings Bank by the Postmaster-General or any person authorised by him.

- (3.) The last paragraph of Section 20 shall be read with the omission of the words “under the Statutory Declarations Ordinance.”

- (4.) Section 21 shall be read with the omission of the words “under the Statutory Declarations Ordinance.”

- (5.) In Section 22 in lieu of the words “Savings ^{Amendment of Section 22.} Banks the Manager of any Savings Bank or “Branch Savings Bank” in the second and third lines, shall be read the words “the Post Office Savings Bank, the Postmaster-General and any person employed in connection therewith.”

3. This Ordinance shall commence on a day to be fixed ^{Commence-} by the Governor by Proclamation in the *Royal Gazette*. _{ment.}
