

mentioned may remain on such land as aforesaid and re-enter upon the same as long and as often as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of making any such resumption and survey.

3. Whoever

Offences and
Penalties.

(a.) Assaults, hinders or obstructs any person mentioned in the preceding section ; or

(b.) prevents or attempts to prevent any such person from entering or re-entering upon any such land as is mentioned in the preceding section

is liable on summary conviction before a Magistrate to a fine not exceeding £20, or to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding three months.

4. The Governor in Executive Council may make regulations for carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance. All such regulations shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*.
