ORDER

MADE BY THE DIRECTOR OF WORKS AND HYDRAULICS UNDER SUBSECTION (3) OF SECTION 44 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1956.

THE SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS (BRIDGES) ORDER, 1957

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Special Speed Limits (Bridges) Order, 1957.

2/3/57

(2) This Order shall come into operation at the commencement of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956.

2. The special speed limits specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto are hereby imposed in respect of the bridges over which roads pass, which bridges and roads are specified in the first column of the said Schedule, in relation to motor vehicles generally.
