MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 5(3) OF THE  
LAND ACQUISITION ACT

THE LAND ACQUISITION (DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION)  
(NO. 2) ORDER, 2011

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Declaration of Acquisition) (No. 2) Order, 2011.

2. Four parcels of land—

(a) together comprising 24.6998 hectares more or less, situate at Plymouth, in the Parish of St. David, in the Ward of Tobago;

(b) described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 8th April, 2009, executed under Survey Order No. 275/2000 and filed in the Lands and Surveys Division; and

(c) having been declared by the President by Order by Legal Notice No. 118 dated 19th April, 2010 as land required for a public purpose and approved for such purpose by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by Resolution of the House of Representatives on 29th October, 2010 and the Senate on 9th November, 2010, have been acquired for the following purpose: housing and government facilities.

SCHEDULE

Four parcels of land together comprising 24.6998 hectares more or less, situate at Plymouth, in the Parish of St. David, in the Ward of Tobago and described as follows:

(a) 11.5644 hectares said to belong now or formerly to Martin Schneider;

(b) 0.8782 hectares said to belong now or formerly to Martin Schneider;

(c) 6.0774 hectares said to belong now or formerly to Chilo Rooplal Singh; and

(d) 6.1798 hectares said to belong now or formerly to Chilo Rooplal Singh.

The parcels of land are more particularly shown coloured raw sienna on a Survey Plan filed as J.R. 12 in the vault of the Lands and Surveys Division, Old General Post Office Building, Wrightson Road, Port-of-Spain.
